

Application to have a name reserved for a municipal political party

Section 399.1 of the *Act respecting elections and referendums in municipalities* stipulates that before filing an application for authorization, the leader of a party may apply in writing to the Chief Electoral Officer to have a name reserved for a period not exceeding six months. The application must specify the municipality in which territory the party intends to carry on its activities and for which it intends to present candidates. A party having reserved a name may, however, ask to carry on its activities under another name in its application for authorization.
