

Application to have a name reserved for a political party

Section 47.1 of the *Election Act* stipulates that before filing an application for authorization, a party may apply in writing to the Chief Electoral Officer to have a name reserved for a period not exceeding six months. A party having reserved a name may, however, specify another name in its application for authorization.

Remark

The requested name must not include the word "independent". Moreover, the Chief Electoral Officer shall refuse to authorize a party if the name of the party is substantially the same as that of an authorized party or of a party that has ceased to be an authorized party, and is likely to mislead the electors as to which party they are supporting (s. 50 of the *Election Act*).
