

HEALTH PROTOCOL TO REDUCE THE RISK OF SPREADING COVID-19 DURING SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS



Register of persons met to obtain a supporting signature or contribution¹

Context

Élections Québec and the Ministère de l'Éducation, with the collaboration of the Ministère de la Santé et des Services Sociaux, developed a health protocol to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19 during school board elections. This protocol includes a set of measures affecting both election preparations (up to and including the conduct of polling), and the candidate's financing rules. It will be available on the Élections Québec website, in the section titled "Elections in the Time of COVID-19."

This protocol includes measures for the solicitation and in-person collection of signatures in support of the nomination paper and the authorization for candidate's financing and contributions. A checklist of applicable health instructions is provided. In particular, contributions must be collected by appointment and the name and contact information of every person met with (regardless of whether he or she decides to make a contribution) must be recorded in a register that can be shared with public health authorities in the event of an investigation. The purpose of this measure is to facilitate such investigations into COVID-19 outbreaks. Regarding candidate's financing, a summary table, will be available on the Élections Québec website, outlines the application of these guidelines.

Submittal of register

This register shall be submitted, as the case may be:

- to the returning officer (or designated assistant), when submitting the nomination paper;
- to the returning officer, when submitting an application for authorization of an elector who undertakes to run as an candidate;
- to the returning officer, when submitting the application for recognition of a ticket;
- to the director general of the English-language school board, along with the contribution receipts.
